






FIGURE 4. PA PROGRAM START AND END MONTHS































Ul PA Program Clinical Year Curriculum


Ul PA Program Clinical Year Curriculum

- 48 weeks of clinical rotations (4 from summer and 44 during clinical year)
- Assigned by director of clinical education after meeting with student
- In surrounding area, Iowa, regional, national and/or international
- Assisted with housing

UI PA Program Clinical Year Curriculum

- Required Clinical Rotations (weeks in length)
- Summer Curriculum (4 Week)
- Family Practice (4) X 2 (one in a rural/underrepresented location)
- Internal Medicine (4 weeks of General IM and 2 weeks of a Sub-specialty)
- Pediatrics (4)
- Surgery (6)
- Psychiatry (4)
- Gynecology (4)
- Emergency Medicine (4)
- Total of 40 weeks of Required Rotations
- Elective Rotations
- Students select 8 weeks of elective rotations







