

UI MOBILE CLINIC



- Vitals
 - Height, blood pressure (manual), respirations, temperature
 - Requires training
 - Usually at the start of the semesters
- Labs
 - Requires training
 - Check hemoglobin A1C and cholesterol
- EMR Expert
 - In charge of electronic medical records
- Interpreter
 - Fluent in Arabic, Spanish, or French
- Patient educator
 - Educate patients on vitals and labs
- HIV/HCV testing
- Scribe
- COVID screener- new!
- Patient advocate
 - Guide patients through clinics

PHYSICIAN SHADOWING (PRE-MED)

Medical School Requirements:

- General: 100+ hours of physician shadowing is ideal if not involved in another clinical experience (e.g. Scribe, CNA, etc)
- General: 50+ hours of physician shadowing if already taking part in another clinical opportunity
- Specific number of hours may depend on the program
- However, quality > quantity
 - Schools care more about the quality of your shadowing than the quantity

Ways to Get Involved:

- Reach out to current providers and/or any family friend's you may have who are physicians
- Write a cold email to a physician you may not know on a personal level




